### OUR LEARNING

#### ENGLISH

We practiced using the expressions "I like" and "We like" to talk about things we enjoy doing.

Children used complete sentences to share their preferences during speaking and book activities.

#### PHONICS

We focused on two new letter sounds. /r/ and /u /  
Students practiced saying the sounds clearly and identifying them at the beginning and end of words.

We also read simple words to help improve reading fluency.

#### MATHS

We worked on subtraction, learning how to find the difference between two numbers.

#### LENGUAJE
