OUR LEARNING

Enalish

We practiced using the question and answer structure: "Would you like some...?" and "I'd like some..." to talk about different food items.

Phonics

We learned the sounds of the letters "h" and "b". We practiced identifying these sounds in words and read simple words to support reading development.

Maths

We continued working on **subtraction**, learning how to find the **difference between two numbers**. We practiced using a **number line** to solve subtraction problems

Lenguaje

Science
